Romans 12:1-2

I totally surrender to God:	I give up the following rights:
My spirit	The right to pleasant circumstances.
My will	The right to be accepted.
My mind	The right to be successful.
My emotions	The right to my possessions.
My body	The right to be rescued from my circumstances.
My circumstances	The right to see the results
My plans for the future	The right to figure out the will of God.
My family	The right to understand my circumstances.
My dreams and hopes	The right to prove I'm right.
My past successes and failures	The right to be loved.
My habits	The right to have a mate or children.
My problems	The right to be used by God.
My relationships	The right to live in the place I choose
My finances	The right to the job I want.

Other rights that I have held which have been shown to me by God and which I now surrender to Him are:

I give God permission to do anything He wishes to me, with me, in me or through me that would glorify Him. I once claimed these rights as mine, but now they belong to God and are under His control. He can do with them anything He pleases.
